

- Part 1: Research Prompts
 - What are the environmental threats that climate change activists are currently most concerned about?
 - What changes are scientists calling for? How long have they been making these recommendations? How dire is the situation and the forecast?
 - What are some of the obstacles that climate change activists face? What are some of the obstacles barring the way of climate change action?
 - What actions have been taken in response to climate change? (You may choose to research on a global scale, or a country/countries of your choice.) What has been the impact of these actions?
 - What types of actions have proven to be effective to combat climate change? What types of actions have proven least effective?
 - What are your thoughts, opinions, or emotions about climate change and global inaction?
 - In your opinion, whose responsibility is it to address climate change? (Your response could be multi-tiered, with different groups being responsible for different things.)
- Part 2: Choice:
 - Write a speech, poem, or letter to a government official.
 - Make a poster educating people on climate change.
 - Make a concrete plan detailing how you will bring about positive climate impact.
 - Make an appeal from the perspective of an endangered species (any format is ok) to world leaders.
